WASHINGTON, DC – Bike the Sites is pleased to offer guided rides on the 7-seater FunCycle in Washington DC. The FunCycle’s revolutionary design allows the riders to sit in a circle, each with their own set of pedals, and includes a Porsche™ steering mechanism and drive train. An experienced guide leads this unique touring experience on a tour in the Federal Triangle district of Washington. As Dr. Seuss would say it’s “good fun that is funny!”

FunCycle rides leave on the half hour Fridays and Saturdays 11AM to 6PM and Sundays and Mondays 11AM to 5PM. The 45 minute tour highlights the Washington Monument, US Capitol, IRS building, National Archives, and other sites. The experience begins and ends at the Bike the Sites kiosk at The Old Post Office Pavilion – 12th St. NW, between Pennsylvania and Constitution Avenues (Metro: Federal Triangle). No reservations are necessary. The cost is \$20 for one person and \$15 for each additional person in the group. The FunCycle is also available for group rentals, special occasions or other private events.

Bike the Sites leads professionally guided bike tours of Washington, DC and rents mountain bikes, accessories, strollers, and mobility scooters. Capital Sites, Monuments, Sites @ Nite tours, and Family Bike Adventures are offered frequently from early March through November, from our convenient location at The Old Post Office Pavilion.
