- Sites@Nite Tour: This evening tour takes you to the National Mall and Tidal Basin when the monuments are less crowded, the air is cooler and the views are magnificent. Explore the World War II Memorial, Vietnam Memorial, Jefferson, Lincoln and Roosevelt memorials and more.

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All three tours last three hours and are easy to ride. “The Locals Ride Free” offer is available for both children and adults and includes bike rental, helmet, bottled water, a snack and the tour. (For out-of-towners the price is \$40 for adults; \$30 for children 12 and under.)
