Bike the Sites is now offering rides on the FunCycle! The FunCycle's revolutionary design allows the riders to sit in a circle, each with their own set of pedals, and includes a PorscheT steering mechanism and drive train. An experienced skipper leads this unique experience through the Federal Triangle district of Washington. Don't miss being the star of your own parade!

Forty-five minute rides of the Federal Triangle area leave on the hour Fridays and Saturdays 11AM to 6PM and Sundays and Mondays 11AM to 5PM. Call 202-842-BIKE for reservations (not required). Fifteen minute rides depart frequently on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays.
